- Familiarity with AWS services, especially those relevant to application deployment and hosting (e.g., EC2, S3, RDS, Lambda).
- Knowledge of how Python works and how it runs in a virtual environment (since we install python in our frontend for use with the code editor).
- Experience with CI/CD tools for automated testing and deployment.
- Must have solid experience with responsive design principles.
- Requires prior experience working with Figma, demonstrating autonomy in consuming designs provided by the design team. This includes understanding and utilizing components, variables, and style guides effectively.
- Soft skills: problem-solving, strong verbal and written communication skills, team collaboration and attention to detail.

NICE TO HAVE:

- Experience with AWS Copilot for application deployment not required but always a plus.
- Familiarity with testing frameworks (e.g., Jest, React Testing Library) for unit and integration testing.
- Knowledge of performance optimization techniques for React and Next.js applications.
- Accessibility (a11y): understanding of web accessibility standards and practices.
- Basic understanding of DevOps practices, especially related to CI/CD with Docker.
